Village Welfare Society inaugurates new old age home 'Anandam - The Nest for Old' for elderly Women at Pancharul

The initiative undertaken with support from Lions Club and Thandulal Manorama Foundation

Village Welfare Society, the social wing of **Village Financial Services (VFS)**, a Kolkata-based leading microfinance company, has set up an old age home called '**Anandam - The Nest for Old' for elderly women at Pancharul in Bengal's Howrah district**. The initiative came into being with help from **Lions Club** and **Thandulal Manorama Foundation**.

The old age home, located on the society's campus, will provide some 60 elderly women with shelter and other necessity amenities free of cost. The home, among others, offers healthy meals, clothes and round the clock medicine facilities with weekly medical checkups and 24x7 on-call doctor services. Besides, it has recreation facilities and offers yoga and meditation classes as part of its day-care activities.

The old age home also has a garden and a temple in it.
